



Care, Learning and Play Policy

Children learn when they are in a safe and caring environment where they are stimulated through play.

Babies and young children develop best when they are in a caring relationship with an adult. A baby will learn to walk faster when they have a safe pair of arms to walk towards and learn to talk, when they have an adult listening and responding to them.

We will strive to provide your child with an environment that will be caring, fun and stimulating. We will implement ideas from the Early Years Foundation Stage and includes:

CL - Communication and Language.

EAD - Expressive Arts and Design

L - Literacy

M - Mathematics

PD - Physical Development

PSED - Personal, Social and Emotional Development

UW - Understanding the World

These activities will include but are not limited to:

Dressing up clothes.

Books and Videos.

Small world toys.

Construction toys (lego, duplo etc).

Pretend play (toy kitchen etc).

Water play.

Arts and Crafts.

Outings.

Cooking.

Gardening.

Outdoor play and equipment.
